Our Lady of Guadalupe

The celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe goes back to the apparitions that took place in December of 1531 on the hill of Tepeyac, near Mexico City. The Most Holy Virgin appeared to the humble indigenous man Saint Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin, presenting herself as the "Mother of the true God for whom we live." She asked that a small house be built there to welcome her children and to offer them the love and compassion of God.

The sign given by the Virgin to Bishop Zumárraga — the Castilian roses blooming in the midst of winter and her image imprinted on Juan Diego's tilma — became not only proof of the apparitions but a true spiritual icon that has endured through the centuries.

The fruits were immediate: within just a few years, millions of indigenous people embraced the Christian faith. Saint John Paul II used to say that Guadalupe represents "the great Pentecost of the evangelization of the New World."

The liturgical feast, celebrated on December 12, is now observed solemnly throughout the Americas, and the Virgin of Guadalupe is proclaimed by the Church as Patroness of Latin America, Empress of the Americas, and Star of the New Evangelization.

The message of Guadalupe remains profoundly relevant. The Virgin does not appear as a distant figure, but as a loving Mother who speaks the language of the people, adopts their symbols, and enters into their suffering. In her image woven on the tilma we see a silent catechesis: Mary appears pregnant, bearing within her womb the Incarnate Word, reminding us of that evangelization always places Christ at the center.

The words she addressed to Saint Juan Diego continue to echo as a spiritual balm for all of us: "Am I not here, I who am your Mother?" The Church sees in these words a true expression of Mary's maternal care for every disciple of Christ (cf. Lumen Gentium 62). She draws near to the anguish of the peoples of the Americas and, as a Mother, she leads everyone to Jesus, the only Savior.

To celebrate Guadalupe is to renew our hope. It is to remember that God enters into our history, our fears, and our fragilities, and through Mary rekindles the missionary fire of the Church.
